ROCKY MOUNTAIN DRIVER TRAINING PROGRAM

The Rocky Mountain Driver Training Program is an extension of the training services provided by the Rocky Mountain Emergency Services Training Center.

The Driver Training Program is conducted on a newly constructed paved driving track, providing a controlled environment for defensive driving and safety. The track includes a 1.2-mile-long oval, 3000-foot straightaway, an off-road recovery area and a six-acre paved skid pad. The facility is conveniently located in Helena, Montana, and is owned and operated by the Helena Regional Airport Authority.

DEFENSIVE DRIVING COURSES

All of the courses listed below are available to anyone with a current driver's license. This includes federal, state, and local governmental agencies, as well as public and private businesses, groups, and individuals.

EIGHT-HOUR COURSE

The eight-hour Defensive Driving Course is a comprehensive training session that gives you a thorough understanding of all aspects of defensive driving. The initial four hours of the course involve classroom lecture and interactive discussions. The second four hours provides each student with a hands-on opportunity to test what has been taught in the classroom. Subjects including off-road recovery, emergency maneuvering, backing, cornering, proper steering, braking techniques, driver awareness, skid control, avoidance, and recovery are simulated on the driving track in various vehicles. Each student receives a nationally recognized certificate from the National Safety Council upon successful completion of the 8-hour course. Cost of the 8-hour course is \$225 per student. Textbooks, study materials, and lunch are all included in the price.
